- II. Service Department/Groundskeeper Discussion
  - The Pavement Improvement Project in Valley View Woods is progressing well. The paving was completed in mid-November, and landscaping was performed during the week of November 29 and will be touched up in the spring. The scheduled seal coating of the Pavilion B parking lot, including the creation of the additional parking stalls through reconfiguring the lot, will take place in the spring as soon as weather permits.
  
- III. Village Logo Contest
  - The rules and entry form for the upcoming Village Logo Contest were reviewed and adopted. The contest entries will be accepted through February 28, 2011 with judging to occur at the March 2011 Recreation Board Meeting.
  
- IV. Information Update
  - Our Youth Basketball Program starts play in the Seven Hills Basketball League on Saturday, December 4.  
NOTE: Valley View has seven teams (one team in each of the 3<sup>rd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> grade boys and 5<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grade girls age groups, two teams in the 3<sup>rd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> grade girls, and three teams in the 5<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grade boys age group).
  - The Annual Holiday Lighting Ceremony is scheduled for Sunday, December 5 at 5:00 P.M.
  
- V. Other Discussion
  - Community Center employee Bonnie Mollica pointed out that the Front Desk Staff experiences frustration at times with the fact that people entering the facility do not check in at the Front Desk as is required. The configuration of the entrance in relationship to the desk is a challenge. The Recreation Department will look into belt or rope stanchions similar to what is used in a bank to see if this can help the issue.

- This contest is open only to residents of the Village of Valley View. The entrant must be a resident at the time the contest winner is selected.
- One entry per resident and there is no age restriction.
- All artwork must be the entrant's original, hand-done creation. Photographs and computer-generated artwork will not be accepted.
- No prizes will be awarded, but the logo will be judged by the Recreation Board, and adopted by Village Council to be used throughout the Village in a manner that is to be determined.
- A completed entry form must be attached to the back of your artwork; do **not** include the entrant's name or any personal markings on the artwork. The entries will be judged on the CONCEPT of the logo, along with the written explanation of the logo. Special consideration will be given to those entries that reflect the heritage, spirit, assets, and culture of the Village as a people and place.
- The artwork must be submitted on 8.5" x 11" paper, should be black and white, and drawn with pencil or pen. Submitted artwork will NOT be returned to entrants.
- All entries must be **hand-delivered** to the Valley View Community Center by the deadline of **Monday, February 28, 2011**.
- All entries must be suitable for public viewing as determined by the judging panel.
- Entries shall be subject to verification and shall be ruled null and void if they are found not to have been submitted in accordance with these Contest rules. By entering the Contest, each entrant (and his/her parent/legal guardian if he/she is a minor) agrees to abide by the Contest rules and all decisions of the Valley View Recreation Board, which shall be **final and binding** on all entrants in all matters relating to the Contest.
