REGISTER NOW FOR 2017 PAVILION LOTTERY

The Recreation Board of the Village of Valley View will continue with the Pavilion Lottery system which has been used since the 2003 season. This system has reduced such problems as double-booking of pavilions; booking a pavilion and not canceling which prohibits use by another resident; and, damage to pavilions (such as nailing of decorations, lights, weather protection, etc.).

The following pavilion policies remain in effect for the 2017 season:

1) A deposit is required to register for any pavilion. This deposit will be forfeited for breaking rules, damaging pavilions and/or other park property, late cancellation, etc.

2) "Pavilion Position" cards are available at the Community Center front desk from now until Wednesday, February 15, 2017 at 10:00 p.m. The lottery, which will take place during the February 16, 2017 Recreation Board meeting, includes all pavilions and will be conducted to establish a "Pavilion Position". This position will allow one resident per household to sign-up for a pavilion by using their "Pavilion Position" on Saturday, March 11, 2017. After April 1, all pavilions are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Pavilion registration rules are available at the VVCC Front Desk.



SNOW PLOWING

To qualify for the snow plowing the following shall apply: The resident must be at least 60 years of age or temporarily or permanently disabled, and have no other able-bodied person residing with the resident capable of removing snow, male or female, over sixteen years old. Medically-impaired residents must present a doctor's certificate or other proof stating the disability. Please stop down to the Front Desk of the Community Center to complete a Snow Removal Application. If you are unable to stop down, you may also call and have one mailed to you. Throughout the season, the Service Department clears the driveways of the residents who have submitted applications and have been approved for the service. Driveways are plowed when the snow reaches at least 4 inches in depth during the normal business workweek, and are not plowed on the weekends or holidays unless the snow reaches over 8 inches. If you have any questions regarding this service, or your eligibility for this service, please call (216) 328-0390. Bags of salt are also available in the lobby of the Community Center for our seniors and our physically-challenged residents.

PAVILION LOTTERY 2017
