- II. Service Department/Groundskeepers
- Groundskeepers Foreman Jeff Gabor indicated that the groundskeepers are changing the goals on the “big” soccer field from steel to aluminum; they are also working on the trail in Valley View Woods to try to fix recent washouts; the training wall at the tennis court in Valley View Woods is up; the groundskeepers are also keeping up with routine maintenance.
- III. Project List
- The Board is in the process of reviewing its project list in an effort to update and re-prioritize any upcoming improvement or maintenance projects. The Recreation Department needs members to submit their completed rankings as soon as possible.
 - The Board is seeking updates on the following projects: approximate start date for concrete border at Lombardo Park playground (this project is expected to start during the week of August 29 and will hopefully be completed during the week of September 5); if ultimately approved, an approximate start date for asphalt work at Lombardo Park and Valley View Woods; approximate start date for testing areas to curb erosion on the path in Valley View Woods.
 - Council Recreation Committee Chair Brad Borowy inquired about the humid air in the Community Center and if a fix has been or needs to be identified. The Recreation Department will work in conjunction with the Village Building Inspector and the HVAC Company for the Community Center in efforts to make improvements. Options may include fans, dehumidifiers, changing temperature ranges, and perhaps more if needed. Borowy stated that he would like to try to get a permanent fix to avoid long-term issues.

- Council Representative Dave Wingenfeld asked if there has been any additional discussion on a splash park/water play area. The Board has not been informed of any additional plans for such a project. The Board's last information was that the proposed collaborative project between Brooklyn Heights, Cuyahoga Heights, and Valley View at the Cuyahoga Heights Municipal Pool was not moving forward in 2016.
