CAUCUS STARTED AT 7:03 PM. MAYOR PIASECKI WENT OVER THE AGENDA FOR THE COUNCIL MEETING. ORDINANCE 2015-11-2 (FLYING MODEL AIRCRAFT) IS ON THIRD AND FINAL READING. COUNCILMAN BOROWY STATED THAT HE LIKES THIS ORDINANCE BUT IS THERE ANY WAY TO PUT WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS ON IT? MAYOR PIASECKI STATED HE WOULD LIKE TO SEE WEIGHTS AND HE ALSO NEEDS TO GET TOGETHER WITH THE CHIEF TO DISCUSS PERMITS. THE FAA IS COMING OUT WITH RESTRICTIONS AND THERE ARE DRONE SITES OUT THERE. IT WAS DECIDED TO TABLE THIS ORDINANCE AND BRING IT BACK ONCE THE NECESSARY CHANGES ARE MADE. ORDINANCE 2016-1-3 IS AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT GRANT FOR EVENT SOURCE. THEY ARE ADDING A FOUR MILLION DOLLAR BUILDING ON TOWPATH DRIVE AND BRINGING IN AN ADDITIONAL \$100,000.00 IN PAYROLL. ORDINANCES 2016-1-4 THRU 2016-1-8 ARE FEMA ORDINANCES TO PURCHASE HOMES. MAYOR PIASECKI STATED IT IS TOUGH TO LOSE FAMILIES IN THE VILLAGE BUT THE ACQUISITIONS ARE FEMA SUPPORTED AND FUNDED. MAYOR PIASECKI STATED THAT COUNCIL MUST ELECT A COUNCIL PRESIDENT PRO-TEMP, REPRESENTATIVE TO THE PLANNING BOARD, AND APPOINT TWO MEMBERS TO THE TAX REVIEW BOARD. THE MAYOR WILL ALSO BE RE-APPOINTING TWO MEMBERS TO THE RECREATION BOARD AND ALL MEMBERS OF THE PLANNING BOARD. LAW DIRECTOR LAMBROS STATED THAT HE HAS MET WITH ENGINEER SCIANO, MAYOR PIASECKI AND DEVELOPER MIKE BOYAS ABOUT A POTENTIAL ASSESSMENT PROJECT FOR THE BOYAS PROPERTY ALONG ROCKSIDE ROAD. HE PASSED OUT A CHECKLIST OF THE STEPS THAT NEED TO TAKE PLACE. WE WILL NEED A MOTION TONIGHT TO HAVE THE ENGINEER PREPARE PLANS AND SPEC AND ESTIMATES OF COST FOR THE PROJECT. MAYOR PIASECKI STATED THIS IS THE BEGINNING OF A LONG PROJECT TO IMPROVE THAT AREA. ENGINEER SCIANO STATED THAT THE CHECKLIST WILL WALK COUNCIL THROUGH THE PROJECT. THIS IS THE LARGEST PIECE OF UNDEVELOPED LAND IN CUYAHOGA COUNTY. COUNCILMAN PERK ASKED IS THIS ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF ROCKSIDE? ENGINEER SCIANO STATED THERE IS SOME UTILITY WORK ON THE SOUTH SIDE BUT THE PROJECT WILL SERVE BOTH SIDES OF ROCKSIDE ROAD. IT WILL BE REFERRED TO AS THE ROCKSIDE ROAD COORIDOR. CAUCUS ENDED AT 7:12 PM.
