RECREATION BOARD MEETING MINUTES

Thursday, February 21, 2019
7:00 P.M. Meeting

- I. Roll Call

- II. Random Selection of Pavilion Lottery Positions
 - Positions were randomly chosen for each resident who entered the lottery (1-222). Letters will be sent to notify each lottery participant that Pavilion Assignment Day is scheduled for Saturday, March 30.

- III. Service Department/Groundskeepers
 - Groundskeepers Foreman Jeff Gabor stated that the groundskeepers are completing equipment and building maintenance projects.

- IV. Senior Aerobics Non-Residents
 - The Board voted 4-0 to maintain the \$2 fee for non-resident seniors to attend aerobics classes. The fee was determined at the October 2018 meeting, and the Board did not want to change that decision. The Board determined they would re-evaluate the fee if the classes become overcrowded.

- V. Project List
 - The Board would like the Engineer to look into the following projects for 2019, including reasonable cost estimates depending upon the scope of the projects: replacement of the pipe beyond the outfield fence at Winik Field and repair areas of the walking path in Valley View Woods that are most prone to consistent erosion. The Board would like to know from the Engineer if the entire length of pipe will need to be replaced, or if there are only specific areas that need to be replaced. The timing of the work at Winik will hopefully avoid major conflicts with scheduled activities, and the Recreation Department will work in conjunction with the Engineer's office to minimize the impact to the schedule as much as possible.

- At the January Council Meeting, Council provided funding for an architect to develop conceptual drawings for a potential kitchen at Pavilions D&E. The Board would also like to consider making the changes to the pavilion at Lombardo as a comparison to the options for D&E. The Board will put this potential project on hold until later in 2019.
- Additional possible projects (batting cage in Valley View Woods and camera work and the potential cleaning of the storm sewer at the soccer field in Valley View Woods) are still in the queue with the Engineer's Office.

VI. Information Update

- Spring Soccer registrations are in the lobby, for those who did not play in the Fall, but wish to play in the Spring (deadline March 1).
- Baseball/Softball registrations and Coaching Applications are in the lobby of the Community Center (deadline April 1).
- Youth Baseball and Softball Clinics (April 28) and Pitching Clinics (May 5) are scheduled for the spring.
- A summer Soccer Camp will be held in Valley View Woods from June 3-7.

VII. Other Discussion

- Board member Rocco Casadonte said he saw information about possibly using clover in goalmouths to help avoid the areas becoming bare shortly into a soccer season. The Recreation Department and groundskeepers will look into the possibility to see if it could be a viable solution as a heartier base for those areas.
