CAUCUS STARTED AT 6:51 PM. MAYOR PIASECKI WENT OVER THE AGENDA FOR THE COUNCIL MEETING. ORDINANCE 2018-10-3 CREATES A NEW POSITION. ONE OF OUR JAILERS CURRENTLY WORKS AS THE CUSTODIAN AT THE POLICE DEPARTMENT. THIS TAKES HIM OUT OF THE JAIL AND PUTS HIM SOLELY AS A PART-TIME CUSTODIAN. ORDINANCE 2018-10-6 IS TO AMEND THE COMPOSITION OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT. COUNCILMAN BOROWY STATED THAT WE TALKED ABOUT THIS AT THE SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING. THIS ORDINANCE HAS US GOING FROM 10 OFFICERS TO 8. MAYOR PIASECKI STATED HE HAS TALKED ABOUT THE COMPOSITION WITH THE POLICE CHIEF. POLICE CHIEF NIRO STATED THAT HE IS TRYING TO ESTABLISH APPROPRIATE MINIMUM LEVELS OF STAFFING. 8 IS ADEQUATE WITH OUR 12 HOUR SHIFTS. 10 WAS AN ARBITRARY NUMBER. THE TRUE NUMBER IS 8. WE RUN 4 PLATOONS WITH ONE SERGEANT AND 2 PATROLMEN. COUNCILMAN BOROWY STATED THAT THE OLD COMPOSITION HAS BEEN ON THE BOOKS FOR A LONG TIME AND HE WANTS TO KEEP IT THAT WAY. MAYOR PIASECKI STATED THAT WE NO LONGER NEED THE DEPUTY CHIEF POSITION. POLICE CHIEF NIRO STATED THAT THE DEPUTY CHIEF REPLACED THE CAPTAIN'S POSITION. THE DEPUTY CHIEF WAS RESPONSIBLE FOR ESTABLISHING POLICIES. A LOT OF THE MAJOR TASKS THAT WERE ONCE DONE BY THE DEPUTY CHIEF'S POSITION ARE FINISHED. THE PRIOR CAPTAIN WAS ALSO THE JAIL ADMINISTRATOR. NOW SGT. SIMS HANDLES THE JAIL ADMINISTRATION WHILE ALSO WORKING SHIFTS. WE HAVE BEEN FUNCTIONING WITHOUT THE DEPUTY CHIEF POSITION SINCE CHIEF MARCH RETIRED. THE DUTIES HAVE BEEN SPLIT BETWEEN THE CHIEF AND LIEUTENANT AND IS WORKING WELL. POLICE CHIEF NIRO REFERENCED ORC 124.491 REGARDING THE DETECTIVE POSITION. THAT POSITION IS NOT AN ACTUAL PROMOTION OR TESTABLE POSITION. IT IS AN ASSIGNED POSITION. IT REQUIRES A DIFFERENT SKILLS SET. PRIOR ORDINANCES HAD NO FORMAL WAY OF DEALING WITH THE DETECTIVE POSITION. CAUCUS ENDED AT 7:06 PM.

COUNCILMAN PERK ASKED SINCE THE LAW DIRECTOR IS NOT HERE CAN WE PUT THIS ORDINANCE ON FIRST READING? IS THERE A RUSH TO GET THIS THRU?

MAYOR PIASECKI STATED THERE IS NO RUSH.

COUNCILMAN WINGENFELD STATED THERE WAS A SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING LAST MONTH AND HE DOES NOT BELIEVE THAT ANY OF THESE ISSUES CAME UP ABOUT ELIMINATING THE DEPUTY CHIEF'S POSITION AND REMOVING ONE OF THE SERGEANTS. HE IS CONFUSED WHY IT WASN'T BROUGHT UP AT THAT MEEETING.

POLICE CHIEF NIRO STATED HE CAN SPEAK MORE TO THE SERGEANT AND DETECTIVE POSITION. THE FIFTH SERGEANT ON THAT ROSTER WAS ME WHEN I WAS A DETECTIVE. THAT WAS CREATED BACK IN 1997 PRIOR TO THE CHANGE IN THE ORC REQUIRING PROMOTIONAL EXAMS. THAT WAS AN APPOINTED POSITION. I WAS A SERGEANT AND A DETECTIVE. THIS IS NOT NEEDED NOW BECAUSE WE HAVE SEPARATE SERGEANTS AND DETECTIVES. THE ELIMINATION OF THE DEPUTY CHIEF IS PART OF STREAM LINING AND CONTAINMENT OF COSTS THAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING ALL ALONG - TRYING TO ELIMINATE UNEEDED COSTS.

COUNCILMAN WINGENFELD SAID THE COMMITTEE IS SUPPOSED TO MEET AND COME TO A CONCLUSION AND THEN PRESENT IT TO COUNCIL. THE MAYOR DOESN'T GO TO THE COMMITTEE MEETINGS. HE THINKS WE SHOULD FOLLOW THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE SAFETY COMMITTEE BEFORE WE WRITE AN ORDINANCE.

COUNCILMAN WYATT ASKED WOULD MR. WINGENFELD LIKE TO PUT THIS ORDINANCE ON FIRST READING?

COUNCILMAN BOROWY STATED HE WOULD LIKE TO VOTE ON IT TONIGHT. HE LIKES THE OLD ORDINANCE THE WAY IT IS. THE ONE THAT HAS BEEN ON THE BOOKS FOREVER. THE FIRE CHIEF IS LOOKING TO HIRE AN ASSISTANT CHIEF AND THE POLICE DEPARTMENT IS LOOKING TO GET RID OF ONE.

ENGINEER SCIANO REPLIED THAT THE CONTRACTOR DEMOLISHED THE HOUSE, LEVELED AND GRADED, AND PLANTED GRASS. THIS DID NOT MEET VALLEY VIEW SERVICE DEPARTMENT STANDARDS FOR CUTTING. THAT LEVEL OF RESTORATION MAY WORK IN CLEVELAND OR FOR THE COUNTY LAND BANKS. WE DID NOT RELEASE ALL OF THE MONEY IN THE CONTRACT. WE HAD THEM COME BACK ONCE AND THEY CLEANED IT UP A LITTLE. WE ASKED THEM TO COME BACK AGAIN BUT THEY DID NOT. THE VILLAGE PERFORMED THE WORK TO GET IT WHERE WE WANTED IT AND THE VILLAGE KEPT THE CONTRACTOR'S MONEY. THESE ARE THINGS WE NEED TO DISCUSS WITH THEM.

MAYOR PIASECKI STATED IF IT SAYS LEVEL AND SMOOTH THEN IT SHOULD BE. THERE SHOULD NOT BE BIG ROCKS LEFT. THEY BROKE A UTILITY WIRE, RUINED A FENCE AND BROKE A NEIGHBORS TREE. WE MADE THEM FIX IT.
