REGISTRATION STARTS IN DECEMBER FOR 2019 PAVILION LOTTERY

The Recreation Board of the Village of Valley View will continue with the Pavilion Lottery system which has been used since the 2003 season. Therefore, the following pavilion policies remain in effect for the 2019 season:

1) A deposit is required to register for any pavilion. This deposit will be forfeited for breaking rules, damaging pavilions and/or other park property, late cancellation, etc.

2) "Pavilion Position" cards can be filled out at the Front Desk starting on December 1, 2018. The lottery, which will take place on Thursday, February 21, 2019 at 7:00 p.m., includes all pavilions and will be conducted to establish a "Pavilion Position". This position will allow one resident per household to sign-up for a pavilion by using their "Pavilion Position" on a to be determined date in March of 2019.

After April 1, 2019, all remaining pavilions are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Pavilion registration rules are available at the VVCC Front Desk.




