CAUCUS STARTED AT 6:31 PM. COUNCILMAN WINGENFELD INTRODUCED ENGINEERING STUDENTS FROM CLEVELAND STATE UNIVERSITY WHO, AS PART OF THEIR SENIOR PROJECT, DESIGNED A PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE OVER THE OHIO ERIE CANAL LINKING THE TOWPATH TO THE RESTAURANTS AND MOVIE THEATER. COUNCILMAN WINGENFELD STATED THAT THE BRIDGE IS 72 FEET LONG AND 12 FEET WIDE. THE COST IS \$124,500.00 INSTALLED. HE THANKED ENGINEERS PAUL DEY AND TODD SCIANO FOR MENTORING THE STUDENTS. COUNCILMAN WINGENFELD STATED THAT VALLEY VIEW IS 4TH IN THE STATE FOR ADMISSIONS TAX. WE COLLECTED \$423,000.00 IN 2019. COUNCILMAN MARCH ASKED WHERE IS THE PROJECTED END OF THE BRIDGE? COUNCILMAN WINGENFELD STATED THE OTHER SIDE OF THE CANAL. COUNCILMAN MARCH SAID THAT PEOPLE WILL STILL HAVE TO CROSS THE STREET (CANAL ROAD). COUNCILWOMAN JAKUBCZAK ASKED ARE THE BRIDGE ABUTMENTS INCLUDED IN THE COST? COUNCILMAN WINGENFELD STATED THEY WOULD BE ABOUT \$20,000.00 EACH. THE WHOLE PROJECT SHOULD BE UNDER \$200,000.00. WE ARE CHASING GRANT MONEY AND THE MAYOR WILL ASK THE METROPARKS FOR ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS. WE WILL ALSO APPROACH THE BUSINESSES IN THE AREA TO CONTRIBUTE. AND WE MAY HAVE A POSSIBLE TIF. COUNCILWOMAN JAKUBCZAK ASKED WHAT IS THE TIMELINE? COUNCILMAN WINGENFELD STATED RIGHT NOW WE ARE IN THE DESIGN AND PLAN STAGE. LAW DIRECTOR LAMBROS ASKED IF COUNCILMAN WINGENFELD HAD ANY PRELIMINARY DESIGNS OR PICTURES? COUNCILMAN WINGENFELD PASSED OUT A PACKET (ON FILE). COUNCIL PRESIDENT WYATT WENT OVER THE AGENDA FOR THE COUNCIL MEETING. CAUCUS ENDED AT 6:45 PM.

CHIEF PAPESH TALKED ABOUT THE MISSING RESIDENT ON 1/31/2020. HE TOLD COUNCIL THAT THE LARGE TEAMS WERE NOTIFIED WITHIN TWO HOURS OF THE INITIAL NOTIFICATION. VALLEY VIEW WAS MADE THE COMMAND CENTER FOR THE SEARCH. THEY HAD 6 DRONES, 10 K-9'S, THE CLEVELAND POLICE HELICOPTER, ATV'S, AND 50 PERSONNEL TRAINED IN LARGE AREA SEARCHES. THE METROPARKS USED THEIR MOUNTED UNIT, AND THE NATIONAL PARK WAS ALSO INVOLVED. DETECTIVES OSBORNE AND FERRANDO WORKED LEADS. WE HAD A SUCCESSFUL OUTCOME.

CHIEF PAPESH THANKED COUNCIL FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THE TWO NEW PART-TIME FIREFIGHTERS.

CHIEF PAPESH STATED THAT FIREFIGHTER JAMIE MEKLEMBURG HAS BEEN APPOINTED FIRE CHIEF FOR THE CITY OF SEVEN HILLS. HE WILL BE SWORN IN NEXT WEEK.

BUILDING INSPECTOR ELLIS HAD HIS REPORT.

STREET COMMISSIONER SOLDAT HAD HIS REPORT.

RECREATION DIRECTOR VON VILLE HAD HIS REPORT.

ENGINEER SCIANO HAD HIS REPORT.

ENGINEER SCIANO UPDATED COUNCIL ABOUT THE BEAVER PROBLEM AT MUDD CREEK. NEORS D CLEARED THE FIRST DAM. VALLEY VIEW ENGAGED CRITTER CONTROL TO TRAP THE BEAVERS. SO FAR ONE HAS BEEN TRAPPED. A SECOND DAM WAS BUILT. RESIDENTS CONTINUE TO ALERT OFFICIALS ABOUT THE BEAVERS AND DAMS. BEAVERS ARE CONSIDERED A NUISANCE BY ODNR. NEORS D WILL NO LONGER REMOVE THE DAMS SINCE IT DOES NOT IMPACT RESIDENTIAL PROPERTIES. THEY HAVE INSTALLED A TRAIL CAM TO MONITOR THE SITUATION.

COUNCIL PRESIDENT WYATT OPENED THE MEETING TO THE PUBLIC.

MS. MARGIE GASPARIK OF 9580 BEYERLE HILL ROAD AND MR. PAUL BLADOS COMPLAINED ABOUT THE HOME AT 9559 BEYERLE HILL ROAD. THEY OWE \$44,000.00 IN BACK TAXES AND UTILITY BILLS. IT WAS IN FORECLOSURE AT ONE POINT. WHAT IS GOING TO BE DONE ABOUT IT?

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BUILDING COMMISSIONER ELLIS STATED THAT THE PROPERTY OWNER HAS BEEN CITED AND CONVICTED AND DID 7 DAYS OF JAIL TIME THEN WAS RELEASED. AS FAR AS THE FORECLOSURE, HE SETTLED WITH THE COUNTY ON A PAYMENT PLAN. MR. ELLIS STATED HE HAS BEEN WORKING ON THIS PROPERTY FOR 10 YEARS.

LAW DIRECTOR LAMBROS STATED THAT IF THE COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT DECLARES THE HOME UNINHABITABLE THE VILLAGE HAS THE RIGHT TO TEAR IT DOWN.

MR. BLADOS INVITED COUNCIL TO COME UP AND LOOK AT THE PROPERTY.

BUILDING COMMISSIONER ELLIS STATED THAT HE WILL MEET AGAIN WITH THE MAYOR, LAW DIRECTOR AND POLICE CHIEF TO SEE WHAT OUR OPTIONS ARE.

MR. RANDY WESTFALL OF NIGHTJAR COURT THANKED COUNCIL, THE LAW DIRECTOR, ENGINEER AND CLERK TREASURER FOR CONTRIBUTING TO THE MEN'S CLUB NIGHT AT THE RACES FOR SO MANY YEARS.
